



MPR Rentals

The Multipurpose Room (MPR) at the Fairway Pool has rental availability year-round with a capacity of up to 60 people based on room set up. With the exception of pool season, the Snack Bar area as well as the Trellis area (poolside) may be added to a reservation



package. Each half of the MPR can be reserved with a capacity of 20-25 based on room set up and includes its own sink and counter space. Use of tables and chairs is included in the rental fee. Renters are responsible for

their set up and clean up of the space. Temporary alcoholic beverage permits are available.


