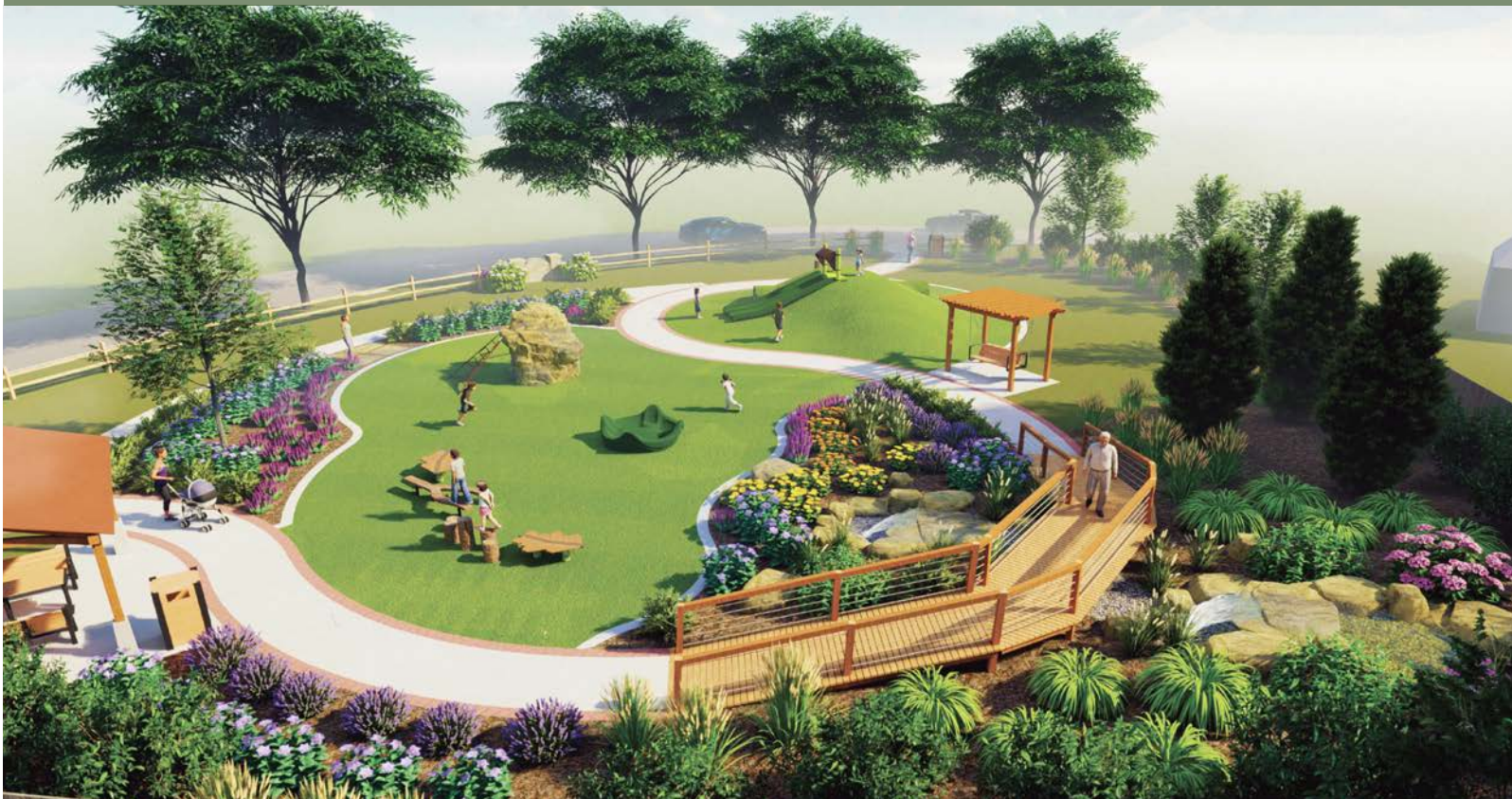

Kathryn Lyon Flora Park

Kathryn Lyon Flora Park or "Kathy's Park" will be located at the intersection of Cherokee and Eastvale. Paul and Susie Lyon have gifted the land and all improvements to the City to build the park in honor of their late daughter, Kathy. The project will go out to bid at the beginning of January. A soft opening is tentatively scheduled for late April with a ribbon cutting planned for July. The final design of the park can be seen below. This "pocket park" includes a waterfall with bridge, small shelter, bench swing, beautiful landscaping and small playground.
